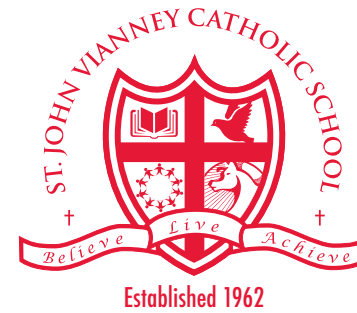

## Our Dream Becomes a Reality

When the students of St. John Vianney returned to school on August 23, they arrived to a new "COOL" school. During the summer, construction of central air conditioning in the school began. The school campus was closed for most of the summer so that construction would be completed in time for the first day of school. This major capital expense could not have been possible without the shared vision of the parish and school community.

In 2008, the Diocese of Orlando launched the Alive in Christ Campaign, a capital campaign to raise funds for the larger church, as well as each local parish community. Father Paul formed a steering committee led by Kevin Walsh to determine the best plan of action for our future. Town hall meetings were held to allow our parishioners to have a voice in determining the most urgent needs of our parish and continue our mission and ministry at St. John Vianney. It was at this time that the dream of central air conditioning took root. It was the number one project supported by most parishioners. With a very generous donation from an anonymous benefactor, specifically for the air conditioning project, St. John Vianney Catholic School Annual Fund dollars and parish funds from the Alive in Christ campaign, the air conditioning project began. After many site visits by the planning team of Fr. Paul, Sr. Elizabeth, Kevin Walsh, Cathy Roche and Jim Roberts, plans were drawn and bids were accepted. Coastal Mechanical was chosen to make the dream of central air conditioning a reality.

Working seven days a week twelve hours a day, the project was completed on August 13, 2010. The teachers and staff were able to return to campus and prepare their classrooms for the first day of school. As Susan Iwuc, 1st grade teacher assistant states, "We're so blessed! The quiet nature of the system allows students and teachers alike to be able to hear each other when reading out loud in class...no distracting window unit sounds! Thanks so much to the parishioners and those who made this project happen."

The exciting changes happening in our school were only made possible by the generosity and sacrifice of many that believe in our mission. Sister Elizabeth said it best, "In the 25 years that I have spent in this school, in this type of climate, I have always felt that central air-conditioning is vital to the students' learning environment. Thanks for the hard work, for those who have dreamed--not just me and the other administrators from the past, but parishioners and parents, and especially our generous benefactor--ALL who have finally made this dream become a reality. Your belief in us, your support for our mission, fills our hearts with gratitude and we will keep you forever in our prayers. From all of us at St. John Vianney School, I say "Thank You" from the bottom of my heart."

## PTO - Building Community AND Adding “Fun” to Fundraising!

Whether your family joined us for “The Brain Show” trivia game, a night of Texas Hold ‘em & Bunco, or the Annual Golf Tournament, last year’s Fall PTO activities provided fun and a sense of community for families and friends while generating significant income towards the PTO’s financial obligation to the school.

January brought WinterFest, kicking off Catholic Schools’ Week in grand fashion. Close to 70% of families participated—a record for PTO events in recent years. Families with students of all ages spent the day enjoying games hosted by the classes, food prepared by volunteers, and inflatables and other fun provided by the PTO. The sense of community throughout the day was not just evident, but contagious! It also exceeded the PTO team’s financial expectations, with the event not just breaking even as hoped, but grossing several thousand dollars for the school!

The PTO’s premier event last year was the Annual Auction, and the theme was certainly appropriate: “SJV--There’s No Place Like Home.” Held on school property for the second year in a row, the auction created excitement among the students for weeks, pulled together countless parent volunteers and attendees, and ultimately generated well over the \$100,000 goal for the school.

Two key responsibilities of the SJV PTO organization are volunteer coordination and fundraising—and the community-building activities throughout 2009-2010 made these goals not just attainable, but fun as well! It was a successful year as the PTO raised more than \$150,000 towards the school’s operating budget and was able to foster a sense of community – achieving two important goals.

We look forward to 2010-2011 as another stellar year with our amazing PTO hosting similar fun events for SJVS families and friends. Joining the line-up this year will be November’s new “Boosterthon” Fun Run, and, of course, April’s Annual SJVS Auction, with its eye-catching and imagination-boosting Dr. Seuss theme. The PTO, school families, and friends of SJVS prove to be an unbeatable combination!

## Reduce, Reuse, Recycle!

### The “3 Rs” at SJVS - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle!

Waste Management has partnered with St. John Vianney School & Parish to roll out a “single stream” recycling program. What is single stream recycling? It means the ability to combine things like plastic, newspaper, plastic, glass, in one recycling bin, without having to separate the items by category. It means that it is fast, easy and efficient.

Our recycling efforts with Waste Management are not only good for the environment, but will prove to be cost effective. Presently, there are three Waste Management bins on our campus. Prior to beginning the recycling program, all three were used exclusively for trash. With our efforts in full swing, one bin has been converted for recycling materials. A savings of \$150.00 on the monthly Waste Management bill is realized for each bin that our community converts for recycling. The goal by the end of 2011 is to have 2 recycle bins and one trash bin, with a savings of \$300.00 per month.

Faculty member, Diane Burmeister, began recycling efforts at SJVS with a group of 5th and 6th graders in 2009. Education and recycling efforts continue this year with 5th and 6th grade Science teacher, Louise Thompson, inviting her students, along with interested 7th graders, to participate in the “We Mean Green” Club. Her students will also be competing in Disney’s “Planet Challenge” Program.

During the first week of school, the entire student body attended an assembly hosted by the Waste Management’s Recycling Team to learn more about our school’s recycling efforts and what we can all do to benefit the planet. Students, teachers and staff were encouraged to share the information about recycling with their families. We are excited to see the results of our effort as we remember the “3 Rs”--Reduce, Reuse, Recycle! Go Green!

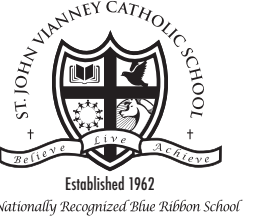

As I look back on 2009-2010, I am especially proud to highlight that St. John Vianney parents, faculty and staff, past parents, alumni and friends continued the tradition of incredible financial support for our Annual Fund, even during the toughest economic environment of our generation. I would like to thank each and every donor for your generous gifts last year. Under the leadership and guidance of our pastor, Fr. Paul Henry and our principal, Sr. Elizabeth Murphy, we have been able to accomplish so much for the good of our students, our faculty, and our facilities. I also want to thank Linda Phelan, Director of the Development Office, and David Trevett from the School Advisory Board, for their commitment to the success of the 2009- 2010 St. John Vianney Catholic School Annual Fund, resulting in a grand total of \$70,835.
