- **FILL-OUT** the following forms and return to the school office no later than **July 30th**. Make check payable to “**SJV PTO**”.
- **EXCITING NEW FEATURE:** Many of our forms at www.sjvs.org, including those below, are now “interactive.” You can complete them by typing online, and then printing them from your computer.
 1. **New PTO Registration Form** (*one required per family; you may have already completed this before the end of the school year. If you have a pink form with a personalized label, please use this.*)
 2. **Clinic Emergency Form** (*one required per student*)
 3. **PTO Volunteer Form** (*one required per family; you may have already completed this before the end of the school year.*)
 4. **Alpha Registration Form** (*as appropriate, if you will be using Alpha after-school care. Note—this is different than preschool after-school care.*)
- **PRINT** 2009/2010 **School Supply** List and purchase supplies.

REMINDER: Book & Technology Fee - \$300.00 per student

Due by July 30th - Payable to “SJV Catholic School” (*This is separate from the PTO Registration form, and due to the front office.*)

Meet the Teacher - Monday, August 17th, 1- 5 pm

- Entrance to Meet the Teacher will take place at the Community Center.
- Student Ambassadors will greet and assist new families at entrance to the Community Center.
- In the Community Center, you will receive a checklist of tasks to complete prior to proceeding to the classrooms.
- Class lists will be posted outside each classroom.
- Meet your teacher and pick-up books and classroom supplies. (Hint: Bring backpacks to carry books home.)
- Look for the Room Parent Sign-Up, which will be in the classrooms this year.

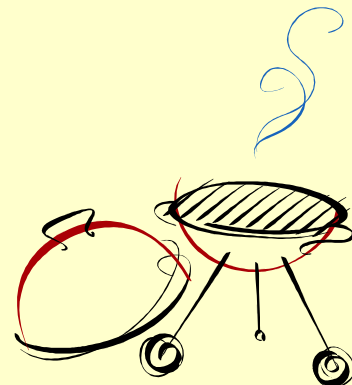
