Counselor's Corner

August 2011 –Transitioning Back to School
Welcome back!

A new school year is a time of great promise, excitement and perhaps some apprehension. Parents can help their children make a smooth transition back to school by having a routine in place that their children know and follow.

A few suggestions that may help are:

1. Make sure all the information the school has sent home has been reviewed and acted upon if necessary. Mark important dates on the calendar. Encourage a more routine bedtime before school starts.
2. Have an established homework place in your home where your child has plenty of supplies and limited distractions.
3. Take an interest in your child's homework and class events. Show your child you care about what they are doing in school.
4. Be positive about school and learning. If issues arise teach your child how to deal with problems in a positive manner.

The beginning of school is an opportunity to establish helpful routines and positive attitudes about your child's school experience. We hope everyone has an exceptional year of learning and growth!
